BLACK WALNUT TOXICITY IN PLANTS

The plants listed below have been reported to be sensitive to Black Walnut Toxicity. Black Walnut Toxicity is caused by a chemical juglone, which is produced by plant parts and roots of Black Walnut trees. The substance is released into the soil and injures or kills susceptible plants under the canopy of Black Walnuts and even beyond the drip line of the tree. Do not plant the plants listed below near Black Walnut trees. This list has been compiled from several sources based on observations and is not scientific, nor complete. Furthermore some species have been reported to have some varieties that are tolerant, while others of the same species are sensitive.
