From local food markets, health food stores, restaurants, resellers, neighbors, and entrepreneurs, these are the enterprises that form a sustainable community, feed their beliefs and energy into the community and add richness to it.

- Investigate Community Supported Agriculture (CSA). In this arrangement, buyer invest with local producers and during the harvest season, get there share of the growers harvest.
